NEW REPEATER

The new club repeater located in East Saint Louis is now on the air. The new repeater is located on top of Kenneth Hall Regional Hospital and is transmitting on 442.275 Mhz with an optional PL tone of 127.3. The repeater is in testing and is not yet linked to the 147.120 Mhz repeater located in Belleville. Once testing is completed and the final equipment is installed at the Turkey Hill site, the repeaters will be permanently linked giving people living or traveling in the Mississippi river bottoms of Metro East much easier access to the VHF repeater.
